#### A) General

#### 1. Registration

- 1. All application forms must be completed legibly, signed with an attached CV, and emailed to projects@sdea.org.sg
- 2. Successful applications will be informed with an email <u>at least 10 days</u> before the scheduled commencement date of the course.

#### 2. Payment of Course Fee

- 2.1. Registration is only confirmed upon full payment of course fees before commencement of the course.
- 2.2. Payment of the course fees upon registration does not guarantee the applicant a place in the course as places are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

## 3. Funding (if applicable)

3.1. The full course fee is **\$\$1250.00**, inclusive of admin and registration fee.

#### 3.2. NAC-AEP Subsidy

Arts instructors who meet the following criteria may enjoy a 50% course fee subsidy:

- 3.2.1. Have at least two years of teaching experience in schools AND
- 3.2.2. Proficient in English language AND
- 3.2.3. Are Approved to conduct programmes under the NAC-AEP 2015/2016 and 2017/2018 OR
- 3.2.4. Have **Conducted** NAC supported programmes

Arts instructors who meet the above criteria will pay only **<u>\$\$625.00</u>** after the course fee subsidy.

Arts instructors who meet 3.2. and is a member of SDEA will enjoy a 70% course fee subsidy. They will

pay only \$375.00 after the course fee subsidy. Applicants may apply to be an SDEA member here.

Applicants must attain 100% attendance in the course and must be certified competent in order to be eligible for the funding. Failure to meet the stated requirement, the individual is liable bear the full course fee without any subsidy.

#### 3.3. SDEA Member Discount

Arts instructors who are SDEA members are entitled to 20% off from the full course fee and pay only **<u>\$1000.00</u>** (including admin and registration fees).

#### 3.4. SkillsFuture Credit Eligibility

Singaporeans above 25 years old who are eligible for SkillsFuture Credit can apply for a claim for this course **here**. Applicants who request for school e-billing will not be eligible for SkillsFuture Credit.

#### 3.5. UTAP (Union Training Assistance Programme) Eligibility

This course has been approved for UTAP support.

Please note that members are required to fulfil the following conditions to be eligible for UTAP reimbursement:

- 3.5.1. Paid-up union membership before course commencement, throughout whole course duration and at the point of claim
- 3.5.2. Course by training provider must be supported under UTAP, and training must commence within the supported period
- 3.5.3. Course must not be funded through company sponsorship or other types of funding
- 3.5.4. Unfunded course fee must be S\$20.00 and above
- 3.5.5. Member must achieve a minimum of 75% attendance for each application and sat for all prescribed examination(s), if any
- 3.5.6. UTAP application must be submitted within 6 months after course completion

## 4. Course Cancellation, Changes or Modifications

- 4.1. SDEA reserves the right to cancel or postpone the course at its discretion without assigning any reason for such cancellation or postponements.
- 4.2. If the applicant wishes to withdraw from the course prior to its commencement and has already paid, the applicant must notify SDEA as soon as possible. SDEA will then make a refund to the applicant. No refund will be granted on or after date of course commencement.





#### 5. Missed Classes

- 5.1. There will be no replacement nor refund for missed classes.
- 5.2. Applicants <u>must</u> attend all the classes and there will be no make-up class for modules missed. Certification will not be granted for those who miss any of the classes.

- 2.3. If a participant falls ill, an original medical certificate by any certified general practitioner or approved public medical institution must be submitted and subject to the assessors' approval.
- 2.4. Punctuality is a sign of professional courtesy to the facilitators and fellow participants. A grace period of 5 minutes will be given for latecomers.
- 2.5. A full 100% attendance is required for participants to obtain certification. Participants who miss or fail to complete any modules are required to retake the whole course to be successfully certified.
